Facultatea de Medicină Veterinară

Anul 2025

În anul 2025, Centrul de Consiliere și Orientare în Carieră din cadrul Facultății de Medicină Veterinară, în colaborare cu cadre didactice, asociații studentești și parteneri naționali și internaționali, a sprijinit organizarea unui număr extins de activități – 52 – educaționale, științifice și aplicative, destinate dezvoltării profesionale și orientării în carieră a studenților.

Activitățile desfășurate au urmărit consolidarea cunoștințelor teoretice, dezvoltarea competențelor practice și facilitarea contactului direct cu mediul profesional veterinar, prin implicarea activă a studenților în contexte educaționale interdisciplinare și internaționale.

1. Activități de consiliere și orientare profesională

În cadrul activităților de consiliere și orientare profesională au fost realizate acțiuni de informare și sprijin pentru studenți și absolvenți, constând în prezentarea ofertelor de angajare destinate absolvenților Facultății de Medicină Veterinară, precum și a programului de internship oferit de Smithfield România, dedicat stagiilor de practică pentru studenții din toți anii de studiu. De asemenea, au fost desfășurate activități de informare și familiarizare a studenților din anul I cu activitatea centrului și cu strategiile de dezvoltare a carierei, în scopul facilitării integrării acestora în mediul academic și profesional.

2. Activități de formare profesională și workshopuri practice

O componentă esențială a activității centrului a fost reprezentată de organizarea workshopurilor și a sesiunilor practice, orientate spre dezvoltarea competențelor clinice și tehnice ale studenților. Printre temele abordate s-au numărat tehnicile de sutură, procedurile de urgență în medicina animalelor de companie, managementul intervențiilor clinice, acupunctura la animalele de talie mică, ecografia veterinară, profilaxia și contenția bovinelor, patologia dentară și radiologia la animale exotice, examinarea clinică a ecvinelor, precum și tehnici de anestezie, intubare, cateterizare și ecografie. De asemenea, au fost incluse activități privind manipularea animalelor paralizate, metodele de examinare în dermatologie, trimajul, osteosinteza și medicina de urgență în practica animalelor mici.



Totodată, au fost organizate activități de instruire practică desfășurate în cadrul fermelor didactice și al clinicilor universitare, oferind studenților posibilitatea de a exersa proceduri medicale, de a înțelege fluxul activităților clinice și de a dobândi experiență aplicată în condiții apropiate de practica profesională.

3. Conferințe și activități științifice

CCOC FMV a contribuit la organizarea unor conferințe și seminarii dedicate domeniilor de interes actual din medicina veterinară. Tematicile abordate au inclus medicina preventivă a rumegătoarelor, medicina ecvină, medicina animalelor exotice, terapia durerii, medicina tradițională chineză, practicile moderne de creștere a bovinelor, condițiile de administrare a fermelor, reproducția și chirurgia la rumegătoare, terapia antimicrobiană, legislația veterinară franceză, osteologia și osteopatia, comportamentul animalelor, sănătatea mintală în profesia veterinară, patologia respiratorie la pisici, fluidoterapia, managementul paraliziiilor la câini, eutanasia animalelor, acidoza ruminală, fitoaromaterapia pentru animale, precum și particularități ale animalelor de companie exotice. De asemenea, au fost organizate videoconferințe dedicate otitelor la câini și pisici, precum și utilizării inteligenței artificiale în medicina veterinară.

Evenimentele au beneficiat de participarea unor specialiști și invitați internaționali, oferind studenților acces la perspective actuale asupra practicii veterinare și facilitând schimbul de experiență profesională într-un context internațional. 4. Activități realizate în parteneriat și implicarea organizațiilor studentești

De asemenea, activitățile au fost organizate în parteneriat cu numeroase instituții și companii, precum Societatea Română de Ortopedie, HS Medical – Vet, Smithfield România, Bioveta.

Prin diversitatea activităților desfășurate și prin orientarea acestora către dezvoltarea competențelor profesionale și personale, CCOC FMV a contribuit la consolidarea relației dintre studenți și mediul profesional, la dezvoltarea spiritului de colaborare și la susținerea procesului de orientare în carieră și integrare profesională.
